SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

Dear members of Classis Central Plains Churches,

As many of you know, there was severe flooding in NW Iowa in the spring of 2024. A number of cities were affected, and two that were hard hit were Rock Valley and Spencer. World Renew, a mission of the CRC, conducted a needs assessment in Rock Valley and Spencer and has placed a long-term volunteer coordinator at Rock Valley to oversee cleanup and reconstruction at a number of homes that are still rebuilding. Having recently secured the materials and work orders, they are eager to receive work groups.

As the Central Plains Classis delegate for World Renew, I have been in contact with the coordinators for the past month, and they have identified two weeks in August for which help is needed. We have the opportunity to establish a volunteer team (of up to 20 people) to go to Rock Valley, Iowa, August 17-23 to assist with sheet rock, mudding/taping, painting, framing, flooring, siding, insulation, landscaping, demo, and more. Volunteers who can't commit to the whole week are still encouraged to sign up as every volunteer can make a difference! High school students who desire to volunteer should be accompanied by a parent.

The cost to individuals or churches is minimal. Two local churches are able to provide accommodations free of charge to volunteer teams. Volunteers would be responsible for transportation and meal costs. More information will be sent to share how churches might assist with the provision of meals for the team.
