The Music Committee report was received for information. Approval was given to a motion from the Music Committee to host a Dordt Hymn Festival on Saturday, November 8. Hosts are needed for 17-20 students.

Approval was given for the use of our church for a Resonate Global Mission staff meeting on Monday, October 20. Pastor David will coordinate logistics.
